We may collect limited information about how visitors use this website, including:

- Your name
- Email address

COOKIES

We may use the following types of cookies:

Essential Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the website to function properly.

ANALYTICS COOKIES

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with the website, such as which pages are visited most often.

We may use services such as:

- Google Analytics

These services may collect anonymised usage information.

MANAGING COOKIES

Most web browsers allow you to control cookies through browser settings. You can usually:

- Delete existing cookies
- Block future cookies
- Receive alerts when cookies are being used
